- Awards to recognise the time you have given.

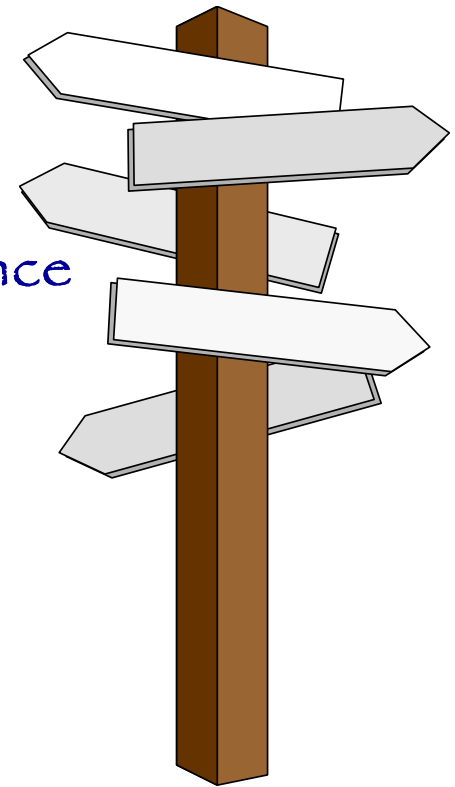


- Young people are supported through their volunteering ~ expenses, follow-up calls, newsletters, training, social events, one-off challenges

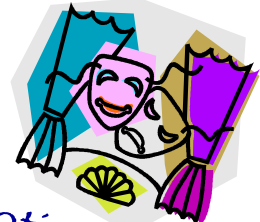

European Voluntary Service

European Voluntary Service (EVS) is a 'Youth in Action' Scheme which encourages 18-30 year olds to undertake long or short term volunteering in Europe.



This programme is for:

- 18-30!
- Those who like travelling
- A commitment of 2 weeks (for groups)
- 6-12 months (for individuals)
- UK resident or EU citizen (or have right to live and work long term in Europe)

EVS provides young people with a real life international learning experience,

It's FREE! The grant covers costs such as:

- Travel (10% is not funded therefore you may need to fundraise this nominal cost)
- Medical insurance
- Food and accommodation
- Training
- Pocket money (amount varies depending on project & destination)
