Planning a Team Challenge

- Confirming costs and budgets
- Organising press coverage and maximising awareness

Income generation from challenges

- Works 4U is a limited company, but one that operates as a social enterprise, therefore all our profit is pumped back into the community

Skills Based Volunteering

- Skills Based Volunteering Pilot Programme aims to transfer vital knowledge from successful businesses to local active small-medium voluntary organisations
- SBV provides access to professional skills and services – which organisations might not be able to afford and are paramount to their development and activity







Skills Based Volunteering

- 10 organisations from H&F Borough were selected to participate in this Pilot Programme with support needed for Marketing, IT, HR, Quality Standards and Events Management
- 3 global corporations are already involved in our programme and we are looking to recruit volunteers from other companies as well







Business Mentoring Forum

 Online mentoring programme to enable young volunteers to create a forum for young people and business mentors in Hammersmith and Fulham

 The purpose of this forum is to provide support for young people from deprived communities in Hammersmith & Fulham in starting their own business or getting into employment







Business Mentoring Forum

- The forum is set-up on categories, such as: Skills Development, Career advice, Networking, Training and we will present Case Studies
- The Events4Youth team was involved in the development of the forum, having consultation meetings with businesses and young people







Business Mentoring Forum

- Development of the online forum might lead to a wider audience and recruitment solutions for corporations
- The forum could generate income by selling advertising space to Universities and companies interested in reaching a wide audience

What can employee volunteers do?

Team challenges:

 Painting, decorating, gardening, tea parties, pub quizzes, sports, reading in schools, helping the elderly...

Skills Based Volunteering:

- Work with local organisations and transfer their skills in the benefit of the local community
- Toolkits on specific areas (IT, HR, Marketing, etc.) will be provided to support the process
- They will have a defined framework than will enable them to make the most of their expertise

Business mentoring:

- Mentoring young people in an online environment, moderated by one of our volunteers
- Providing support on their area of expertise









How can you work with businesses?

- Identify business with Corporate Social Responsibility programmes
- Prepare a plan based on the CSR policy to approach a company

- Present your organisation as a service provider that can deliver their CSR objective
